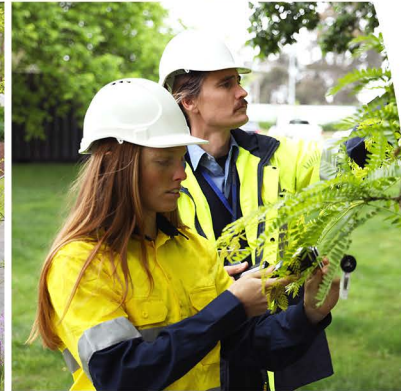
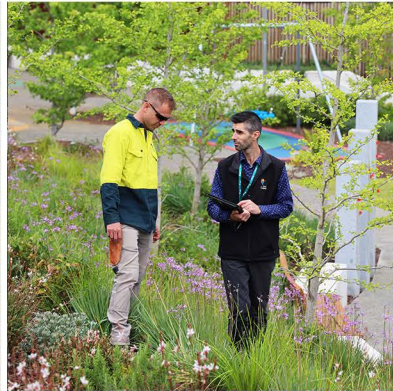

Membership Categories and Fees

Whether you are just starting your journey in the arb industry, or you're well established with your own company and years of experience, we have membership options to support your goals.

All Arb Aus memberships include general membership and can then be tailored with professional recognition options (Registered Membership) and/or affiliate memberships. Memberships are fully tax deductible and valid for a calendar year.

Individual General Membership

\$260 incl GST

A General Membership is for anyone. You could be a newly qualified tree worker, an experienced arborist and business owner, a trainer, office support staff, or you could have a particular interest in trees.

Bulk General Membership

\$880 incl GST

This category is sometimes called Corporate Membership but applies whether you own a company, are an organisation, or part of a local government. If you have multiple employees you will benefit from this discounted Bulk General Membership (Corporate Membership). This membership includes 5 General Memberships (33% discount) and any additional members to your account will be added at the same rate (\$176 per person).

Registered Membership - Professional Recognition

Registered Membership is optional, but in an unregulated industry, it offers you the professional recognition you deserve and a marketing edge for your business. In addition to the benefits listed on page 2, your e-logo and e-certificate are specific to your registered category and your business is added to our Find-an-Arborist website directory.

All categories of registered membership require Arb Aus approval and you must:

- » Hold Public Liability Insurance to the value of \$20 million over the calendar year.
- » Hold Australia Qualification Framework qualifications - see each category for details.

Registered Practicing Arborist

\$580 incl GST

You are a practicing arborist who can undertake practical operations in tree care.

Requires AHC30810 or later - Certificate III in Arboriculture; 12 CEUs per calendar year; insurance.

Registered Consulting Arborist

\$580 incl GST

You have the experience and education to provide diverse, specialised arboricultural services in a consulting arborist capacity.

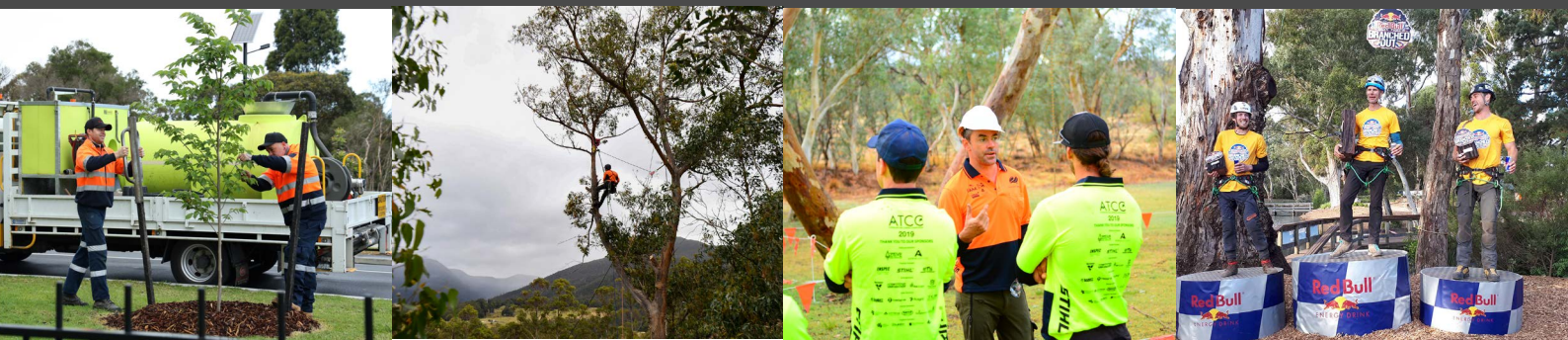
Requires AHC50510 or later - Diploma of Arboriculture (Level 5); 12 CEUs per calendar year; insurance.

Registered Consulting and Practicing Arborist

\$880 incl GST

This is our most comprehensive membership package. You have undertaken all your formal training and are experienced as both a practicing and consulting arborist.

Requires AHC50510 and AHC30810 or later; 18 CEUs per calendar year; insurance.
